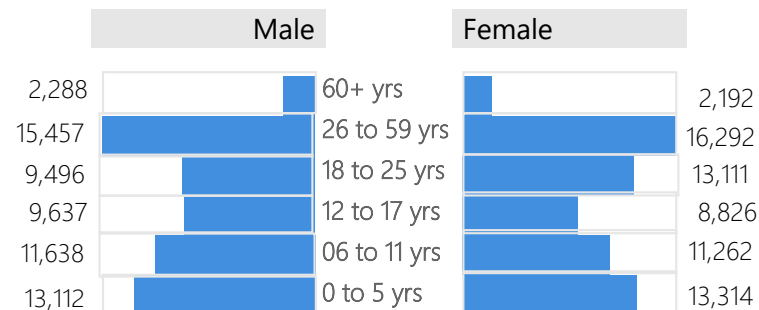

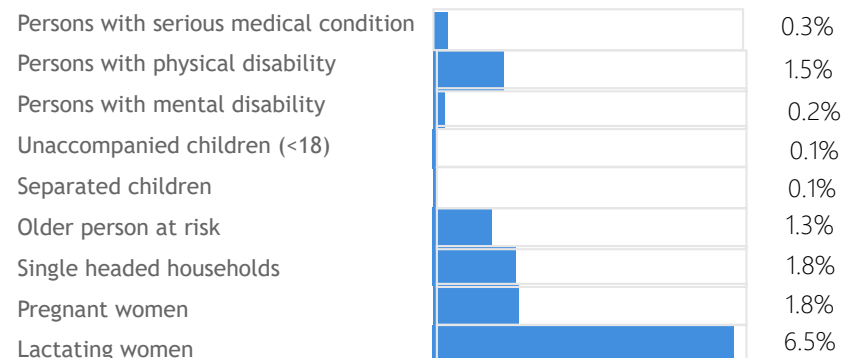

Age and sex breakdown



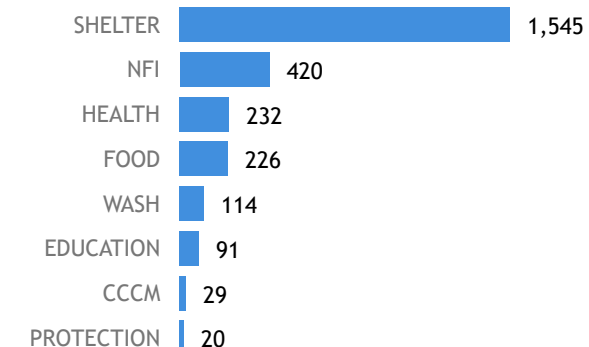

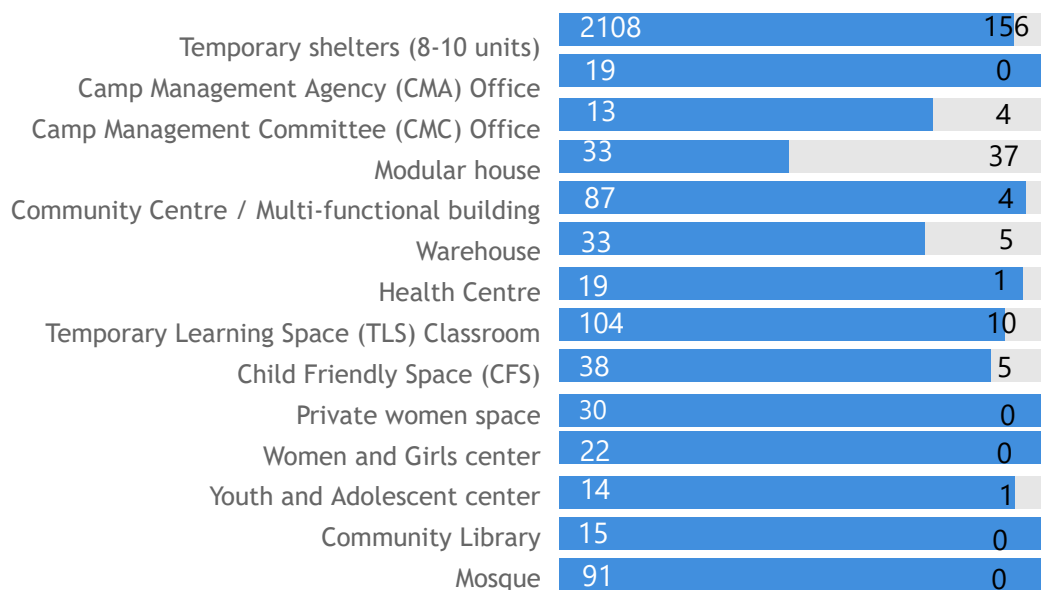

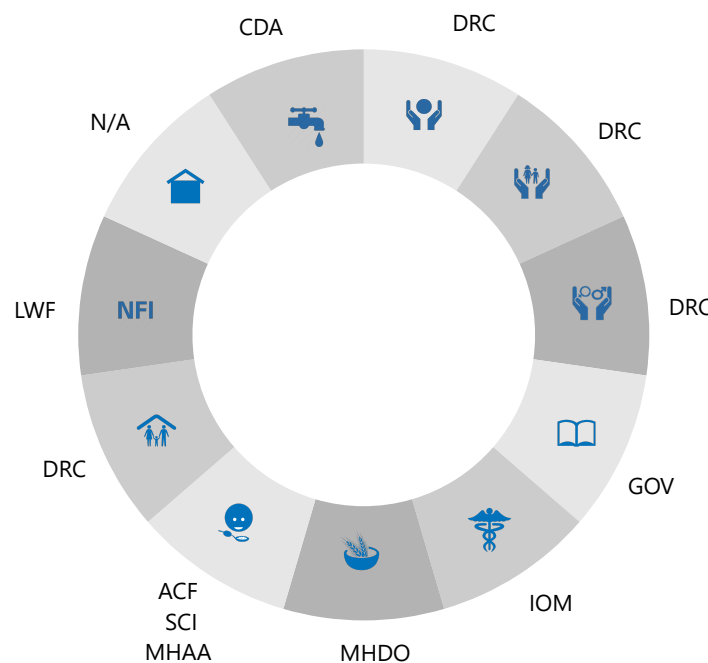


Status of community structures
