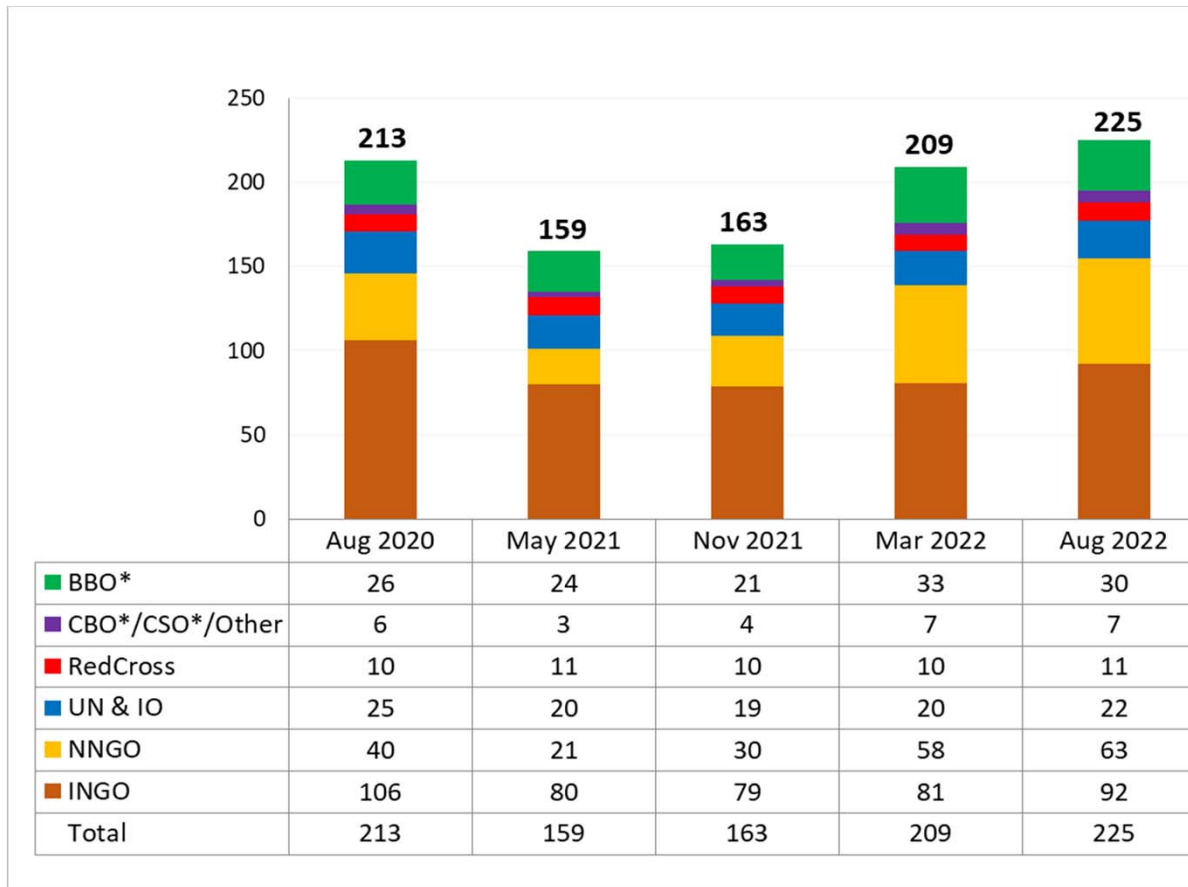

No. of Organizations reporting 5W Updates



16 more agencies reported in Aug 2022 compared to Mar 2022 (8% increasing), mainly INGOs (11 more organisations) and NNGOs (5 more organisations).

Additional Data Protection measures since 2021



1) Agency names no longer appear in Public products

- But may be shared in 5W data for restricted use by contributing agencies, for inter-agency coordination.

2) Agencies decide level of data protection when submitting their 5W inputs

- **Open** – agency names can be shared for restricted purposes (contributing ags, inter-agency coordination)
- **Restricted** – agency name is marked UNSPECIFIED, including in restricted products

Overview of the August 2020 3W

KACHIN State



The MMU 3W gathers inputs from participating humanitarian and development agencies on Who is doing What, Where, across Myanmar. It is conducted every 6 months and provides information on agencies' activities at various levels: village, township, and IDP camps.

In total, 211 agencies participated in the August 2020 3W, providing information on their humanitarian and development activities across 22 sectors and 157 sub-sectors as defined by technical/sector working groups. 89 reporting is quite comprehensive for projects of INGOs, UN and Red Cross agencies, but there is under-reporting of activities for local NGOs and CBOs, unless they are participating. Agencies must be prepared to sufficiently detailed village (or camp) level for this work to be reflected fully in the MMU 3W products.

This Overview describes **projects** under implementation in Kachin as of August 28, 2020. Further information on **planned and recently completed** projects is available from the 3W database, published on the MMU website. 1. Organizations active in Kachin State

A total of 73 agencies reported activities in Kachin state: 50 are engaged in Development-focused projects (396 village/township-based), 17 are engaged in support to other vulnerable groups (not IDP-related, 274 village/township-based), 29 are engaged in activities which target IDPs and Host Communities (115 village/township-based and 118 camp-based) and 23 are engaged in IDP-focused activities (65 village/township-based and 134 camps). IDP-related projects were reported in a total of 125 camps/camp-like settings.

A total of 173 projects were implemented in Kachin State: 33% of the projects involve work with IDPs (56 IDP Host Community or IDP-focused projects), and 68% have a focus on other populations (117 Other Vulnerable groups or IDP Development-focused projects).

Non-IDP Development projects (Other Vulnerable Groups and/or Development Activities): 59 organizations reported 117 village or township-based projects under implementation in 462 village/townships. The majority are implemented by INGOs. Most of the reported projects are from Participating Humanitarian and Development Agencies (14), WFP (14), UNHCR (14), MGOs (36), Myanmar (32), Bhomo (31), Shwaga (30) and Mong Hsat (28).

IDP & Host Community and IDP-only focused activities: 38 organizations reported 56 projects under implementation in 236 village/townships and 135 IDP camps. The majority are implemented by INGOs and UNHCR agencies. Most of these projects are from Participating Humanitarian and Development Agencies (14), WFP (14), UNHCR (24), Shwaga (21) and Bhomo (22 and 11), Bhomo (17 and 8), Myintkyia (16 and 26), Mong Hsat (15 and 11), Mohyinda (14 and 5) and Hpakant (13 and 22).
