MoHS Statement on COVID-19 (6 March 2020, 9:15PM) (Link) (Unofficial translation by OCHA)

- 1. The Ministry of Health and Sports (MoHS) has been speeding up the measures on monitoring and preventing COVID-19 and testing nasal swabs from suspects and Persons Under Investigation (PUI) at the National Health Laboratory (NHL) in Yangon.
- 2. In doing so, the NHL in Yangon has released the results on the night of 6 March 2020, stating that the following patients tested negative for COVID-19.
- (a) A 28-year-old man in Kan Pike Ti Station Hospital [Kachin State]
- (b) A 27-year-old woman in Muse General Hospital [northern Shan State]
- (c) A 35-year-old man in Nay Pyi Taw 1,000-beded Hospital
- (d) A 68-year-old woman in Mandalay Kandawnadi Hospital.
 (The death of the patient stated under (d) has already been stated in the MoHS's statement at 8:00PM on 6 March 2020.)
- 3. The MoHS will keep updating the results of the laboratory when available.
