

MoHS Statement on COVID-19 (6 March 2020, 9:15PM) ([Link](#))
(Unofficial translation by OCHA)

1. The Ministry of Health and Sports (MoHS) has been speeding up the measures on monitoring and preventing COVID-19 and testing nasal swabs from suspects and Persons Under Investigation (PUI) at the National Health Laboratory (NHL) in Yangon.
2. In doing so, the NHL in Yangon has released the results on the night of 6 March 2020, stating that the following patients tested negative for COVID-19.
 - (a) A 28-year-old man in Kan Pike Ti Station Hospital [Kachin State]
 - (b) A 27-year-old woman in Muse General Hospital [northern Shan State]
 - (c) A 35-year-old man in Nay Pyi Taw 1,000-bedded Hospital
 - (d) A 68-year-old woman in Mandalay Kandawnadi Hospital.
(The death of the patient stated under (d) has already been stated in the MoHS's statement at 8:00PM on 6 March 2020.)
3. The MoHS will keep updating the results of the laboratory when available.
