MoHS Statement on Novel Coronavirus (15 February 2020, 8:00AM) (Link) (Unofficial translation by OCHA)

- 1. Accelerating the measures on monitoring, prevention and controlling of the COVID-19, the Ministry of Health and Sports (MoHS) continued to monitor and treat 21 patients at designated hospitals as of 8:00 PM of 14 February 2020.
- 2. The patients who had been treated and monitored included:
 - 1) A 19-year-old man from Sao San Tun Hospital in Taunggyi Town [Southern Shan State];
 - 2) A 32-year-old woman from Puteekone Station Hospital [Bago Region];
 - 3) An 18-year-old woman from Ponnagyun Township Hospital [Rakhine State];
 - 4) A 45-year-old woman from Magway Hospital [Magway Region];
 - 5) A 53-year-old man from Mandalay Hospital [Mandalay Region];
 - 6) A 24-year-old woman from Mandalay Hospital [Mandalay Region];
 - 7) A 29-year-old woman from Weibargi Hospital [Yangon Region] (the woman who returned from Singapore to Myanmar on 5 February 2020);
 - 8) A 21-year-old man from Maungdaw Hospital [Rakhine State];
 - 9) A 34-year-old woman from Pauk Township Hospital [Magway Region];
 - 10) A 44-year-old man from Mawkmai Township Hospital [Southern Shan State];
 - 11) A 44-year-old woman from Mawkmai Township Hospital [Southern Shan State];
 - 12) A 19-year-old woman from Mawkmai Township Hospital [Southern Shan State] and
 - 13) A 16-year-old woman from Mawkmai Township Hospital [Southern Shan State].

In the evening of 14 February 2020, the designated laboratory has replied to the MoHS that those 13 patients tested negative for COVID-19.

3. The MoHS will keep updating the test results of remaining patients being monitored at designated hospitals, as soon as tested.
