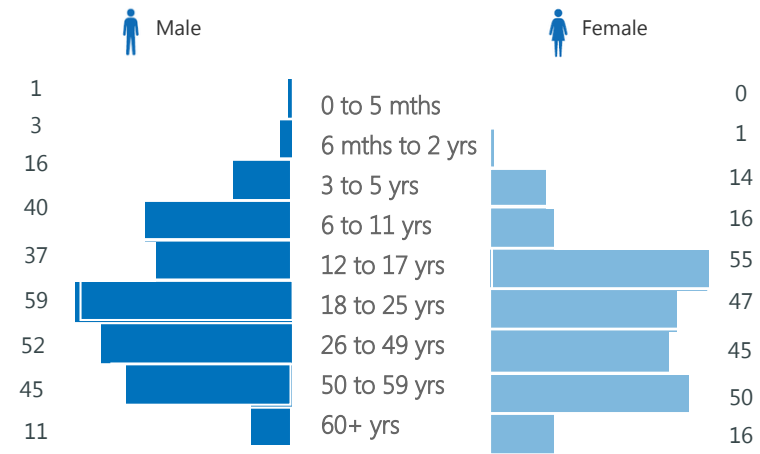

The main objective of the profile is to provide an updated overview of the situation in camps hosting IDPs, including disaggregated population estimates.
