MAIN TASKS

- Support Outcome Manger and Senior Grant Officers with administrative tasks related to compliance, generating grant documents, and mailing agreements and payments.
- Coordinate with grantees, partners, and service providers to ensure smooth and timely implementation
 of activities in line with grant agreements.
- Maintain grant making information in databases and other systems as directed by Senior Grant Officers and Manager.
- Supervise and follow up with grantees to ensure that project deliverables and contractual obligations are met.
- Involve in project implementation, supervision and appropriate documentation in relation to contractual obligations under grant agreement.
- Actively involved in managing grantees and monitoring the implementation progress of RBF+ Grantees.
- Ensure appropriate systems are in place for filing and input to computerized databases are accurate plus experience in preparing grant disbursement schedules and managing errors and delays.
- Provide technical supervision of supported activities within one or more of the three windows of the RBF+.
- Coordinate meeting logistics for both on-site and off-site meetings, including renting space and catering services as needed, travel arrangements, and preparing meeting materials.

- Involve in data collection process of RBF+ Grantees.
- Monitor project activities in coordination with the M&E team, ensuring timely data collection and documentation from grantees.
- Assist in compiling field visit reports, milestone verification notes, and periodic grantee updates for Outcome Managers and Senior Grant Officers.
- Contribute to drafting donor and government reports by providing inputs and data on implementation progress and challenges.
- Participate in assessments, evaluations, and lessons learned exercises to improve project design and delivery.
- Represent the program in meetings, working groups, and networking platforms relevant to assigned sectors and geographies.
- Promote inclusive and participatory approaches by engaging with women, youth, and marginalized groups during project activities.
- Facilitate dialogue and feedback with communities and partners to strengthen accountability and local ownership of the projects.
