POST SUMMARY: The Karen Ethnic Health Organization Consortium (KEHOC) is seeking a compassionate, highly motivated, and experienced Lab Technician to join our dedicated team at our Anti-Retroviral Treatment (ART) Center in Shwe Koke Ko, Myawaddy township, Karen state. This is a crucial role in providing essential laboratory support for the diagnosis, monitoring, and management of individuals living with HIV. The Lab Technician will be responsible for performing a range of laboratory tests essential for HIV diagnosis, monitoring treatment efficacy, and detecting opportunistic infections. This includes sample collection, processing, analysis, quality control, and accurate reporting of results, all while maintaining a safe and efficient laboratory environment.

Key Responsibilities:

- Perform phlebotomy and collect various biological samples (blood, urine, etc.)
 from patients in a professional and safe manner.
- Process and prepare samples for laboratory analysis according to established protocols.
- Conduct a variety of laboratory tests relevant to HIV/AIDS management, including but not limited to:
 - CD4 cell count (e.g., using flow cytometry or point-of-care devices)
 - HIV viral load testing (if applicable), Complete Blood Count (CBC),
 Liver Function Tests (LFTs), Renal Function Tests (RFTs), Blood
 Glucose

- Screening tests for opportunistic infections (e.g., TB sputum microscopy, cryptococcal antigen)
- Operate and maintain laboratory equipment and instruments, ensuring proper calibration and functionality.
- Implement and adhere to strict quality control procedures to ensure accuracy and reliability of test results.
- Maintain accurate and detailed records of all laboratory tests performed, results, and quality control data.
- Report critical and abnormal results to the medical doctor promptly and accurately.
- Manage laboratory supplies and reagents, including inventory control, ordering, and proper storage.
- Ensure proper waste disposal and maintain a clean and sterile laboratory environment.
- Adhere to all biosafety guidelines and standard operating procedures (SOPs) to prevent contamination and ensure personal safety.
- Participate in internal and external quality assurance programs.
- Collaborate effectively with medical doctors, nurses, and other healthcare professionals to ensure timely and effective patient care.
- Participate in training and capacity building initiatives as required.

Qualifications:

- Strong knowledge of laboratory procedures, quality control, and biosafety protocols.

Experience with operating and troubleshooting common laboratory equipment.

Excellent attention to detail and strong analytical skills.

Ability to maintain accurate records and manage data effectively.

Strong commitment to public health and serving the Karen community
