Purpose: Guided by World Concern's global strategic plan, the Program Manager provides leadership and direction to World Concern Myanmar in operation and management of area development programs and multi-sectoral projects coordinating with technical specialists, project managers and area managers. The Program Manager leads in develop projects and programs designs and strategies, exploring funding opportunity and meeting with donors, recruitment and management of project managers and technical specialists in country office and areas managers in field offices, strengthen the capacity of staff, monitor outcomes and progress of the program team to achieve the organization's goals.

### Key Responsibilities:

- Develop holistic strategies and designs by facilitating other sectors: health, agriculture and livelihood, emergency relief and disaster response, child protection and women empowerment in collaboration with technical specialists.
- Lead to undertake assessments on pressing needs of Myanmar, mapping to define priority areas and issues, conduct partnership assessments to explore potential partners and religious groups and government counterparts.
- Facilitate to formulation of objectives and indicators for new projects collaboration with area managers, project managers, technical specialists and field staff.
- Develop draft staffing plans and budgets for new programs/project.
- Coordinate with HQ to have technical guidance and approval for project proposals in timely

manner.

- Liaise with donors for proposals submission, funding agreement and contract signing process and smooth implementation of the projects.
- Review draft donor contracts and provide feedback on these to Country Director.
- Responsibilities include managing at least three projects.
- Provide managerial support to area program managers in project inception phase including recruitment of staff, orientation trainings for staff, stakeholders' meetings, financial and other administrative management.
- Provide guidance to project managers and area managers in order to produce high level deliverables in line with approved proposals and to yield output, outcome and impact level results.
- Provide guidance to area managers in development of detailed implementation plan including procurement plans, technical support and staff capacity building plans and quarterly and monthly budgets.
- Review and approve quarterly and monthly activity plans, budgets and fund requests of implementing partners, project managers and area managers.
- Review and approve quarterly and monthly activity plans, budgets and fund requests of implementing partners, project managers and area managers.
- Ensure to develop a monitoring framework for each project/program including suitable forms and aggregation tools collaboration with a MEAL Manager and project managers/technical specialists.
- Ensure that implementation of WCM projects activities are community led and driven technically sound and sustainable as well as in line with current international best practice standards.
- Provide guidance to project managers to design and area managers to implement the projects using a project cycle management approach and ensure to undertake baseline assessment, mid-term evaluation and end of the project evaluation to produce evidence-based outcomes.
- Strengthen the collaboration and networking between government agencies, UN organizations, INGO/NGO, key stakeholders and local partners.
- Conduct monthly and quarterly program team meetings for monitoring the progress of projects activities and plan for next month collaboration with project managers and area managers.

- Additional studies in management, health, WASH or development preferred
- At least 5 years of experience in senior level management including people management, public health and multisectoral development projects, management including grants management.

- Proven leadership in managing crisis situations and working in high-pressure environments.

- Experience in logistics, security management, and field operations.
